

TLC Retreat 2024 FAQ

Who:

Texas Ladies in Christ Retreat is designed to be a weekend for spiritual growth and fellowship with sisters in Christ (age 15+; mothers with infants under one year of age may bring the child, though we can only allow up to 4 infants at the retreat) from across the great state of Texas... and beyond! Registration is capped to the first 100 ladies, so apply early.

What:

This year, we will do a study of Jonah and Nahum. Be prepared to study deep into God's word! But, don't worry – there will be plenty of time to just socialize and get to know one another better.

When:

Thursday, October 3, 2024 (check-in begins at 5:00pm with dinner at 6:00) through Saturday, October 5, 2024 (we'll leave before lunch). However, if you can only come for one night or for just a single day, those options are available at a reduced rate.

Where:

The Heart of Texas Bible Camp, located in Brady, TX. The camp is located just west of downtown off Highway 87 (take Jacqueline Ruffin Road just past Rest Haven Cemetery... It will lead you straight into the camp).

Why:

To exhort each other, to help in our personal study of the Bible, to equip us to better serve in God's kingdom, to make lifelong connections.... The list goes on and on!

How:

Simply turn in the registration form with your registration fee. The fee for the entire weekend is \$55 and includes all meals, lodging, and a notebook of the speakers' notes (unless you are aged 15-21 – your fee is only \$35!). If you are only able to come for one night (for example, arrive on Friday and leave Saturday), the fee reduces to \$45. If you are unable to spend a night at all, but would like to come for a single day (either Friday or Saturday), the fee will be \$35.

Once again, your t-shirt is included in the price!

You can register online or print and mail in the registration form. Due to the changes in PayPal's tax setup, you will have to mail in your registration fee (address and info is on the registration form). Remember: your registration is not complete until we have **both** your information and your fee in hand and have sent you a confirmation email.
